MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF GLENDALE, COLORADO

1. Call to Order and Roll Call. Mayor Dunafon called the regular meeting of the Council to order. Veronica Marvin, City Clerk, called roll. 
